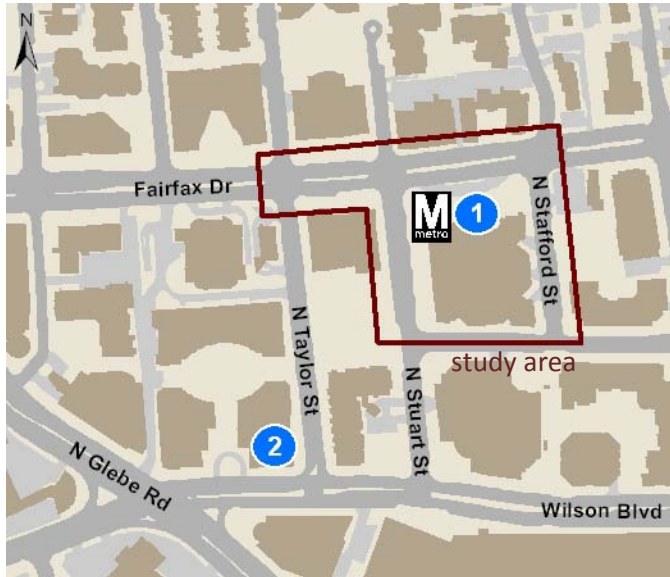


Ballston Station Multimodal Study

stakeholder meeting



Arlington County and Metro invite you to a meeting to discuss short-term and long-term improvements to the Ballston Metro Station area. The two partner agencies have initiated a conceptual study to improve the Ballston Metro plaza and nearby streets. Although the Metro station area is active and provides many transportation options, these very conditions – in its current configuration – diminish circulation and safety.

The **Ballston Station Multimodal Study** will identify, analyze, and recommend enhancements that will encourage safer and smoother pedestrian and transit circulation and will improve the design of the plaza for all users.

You are invited to our first stakeholder meeting on **Thursday, June 10**. To fully understand the Ballston station area issues, we need your input as a daily user, resident, and/or stakeholder. There are two parts to the meeting (see left).
