- Expanded public space on Fairfax Drive.

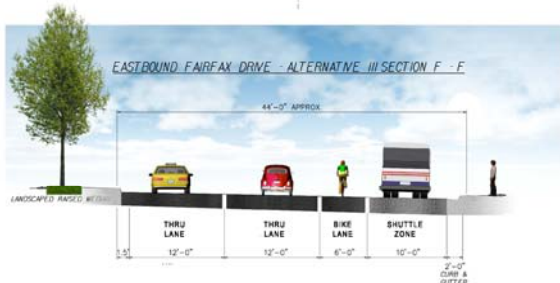


Needs Addressed

- Reduce transit congestion and conflict between different modes of transportation.
- Improve pedestrian safety and accessibility.
- Use landscaping to define the plaza, pedestrian circulation zone.
- Improve transit shelter facilities and reduce conflicts between transit and retail zones.
- Improve public space design to better integrate retail, performance area, and vendors kiosks.
- Increase use of bio-retentive landscaping and paving to reduce heat island effect improving overall comfort and sustainability.
